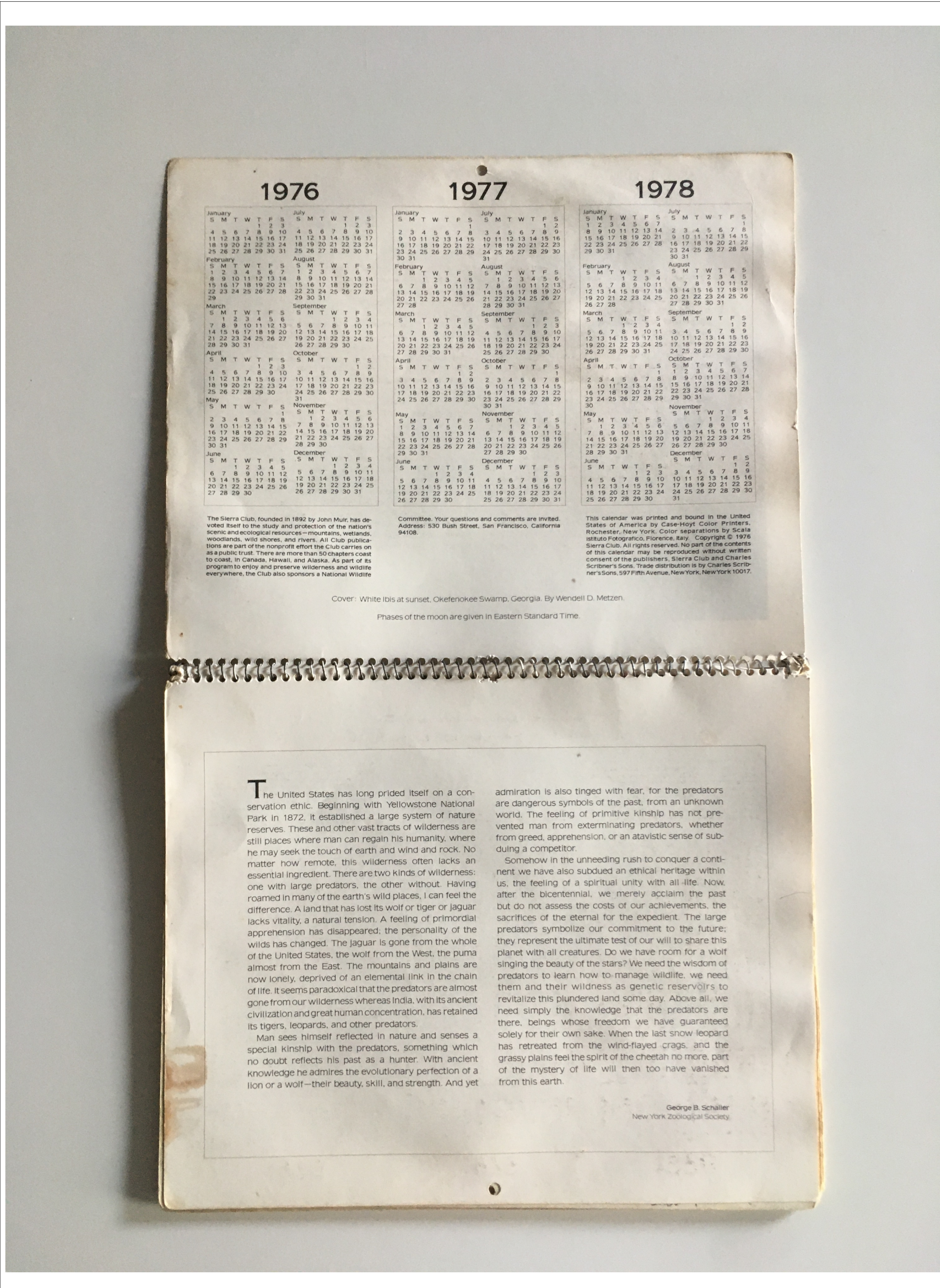

The United States has long prided itself on a conservation ethic. Beginning with Yellowstone National Park in 1872, it established a large system of nature reserves. These and other vast tracts of wilderness are still places where man can regain his humanity, where he may seek the touch of earth and wind and rock. No matter how remote, this wilderness often lacks an essential ingredient. There are two kinds of wilderness: one with large predators, the other without. Having roamed in many of the earth's wild places, I can feel the difference. A land that has lost its wolf or tiger or jaguar lacks vitality, a natural tension. A feeling of primordial apprehension has disappeared; the personality of the wilds has changed. The jaguar is gone from the whole of the United States, the wolf from the West, the puma almost from the East. The mountains and plains are now lonely, deprived of an elemental link in the chain of life. It seems paradoxical that the predators are almost gone from our wilderness whereas India, with its ancient civilization and great human concentration, has retained its tigers, leopards, and other predators.

Man sees himself reflected in nature and senses a special kinship with the predators, something which no doubt reflects his past as a hunter. With ancient knowledge he admires the evolutionary perfection of a lion or a wolf—their beauty, skill, and strength. And yet

admiration is also tinged with fear, for the predators are dangerous symbols of the past, from an unknown world. The feeling of primitive kinship has not prevented man from exterminating predators, whether from greed, apprehension, or an atavistic sense of subduing a competitor.

Somehow in the unheeding rush to conquer a continent we have also subdued an ethical heritage within us, the feeling of a spiritual unity with all life. Now, after the bicentennial, we merely acclaim the past but do not assess the costs of our achievements, the sacrifices of the eternal for the expedient. The large predators symbolize our commitment to the future; they represent the ultimate test of our will to share this planet with all creatures. Do we have room for a wolf singing the beauty of the stars? We need the wisdom of predators to learn how to manage wildlife, we need them and their wildness as genetic reservoirs to revitalize this plundered land some day. Above all, we need simply the knowledge that the predators are there, beings whose freedom we have guaranteed solely for their own sake. When the last snow leopard has retreated from the wind-flayed crags, and the grassy plains feel the spirit of the cheetah no more, part of the mystery of life will then too have vanished from this earth.

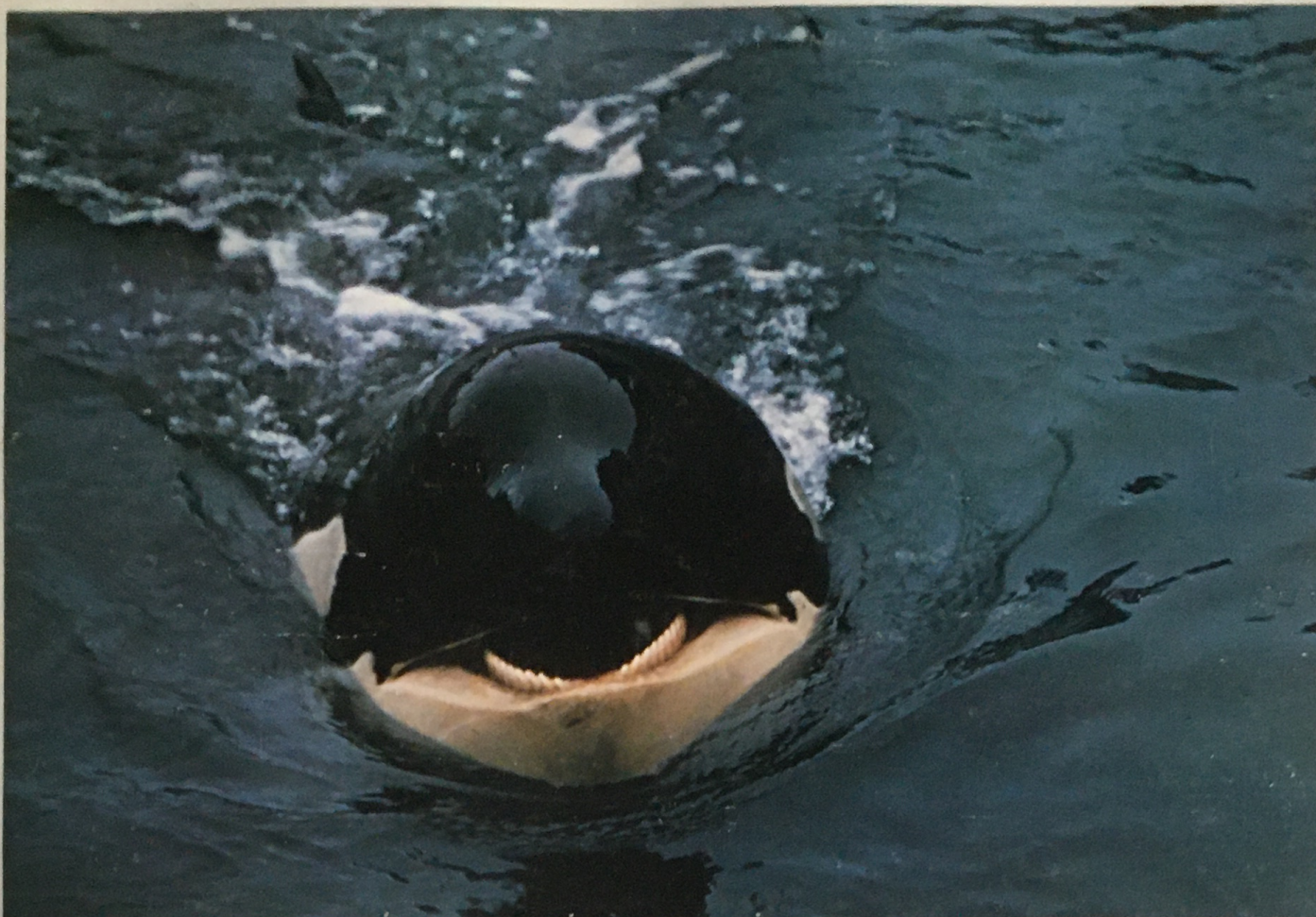
