GAUGER, FOLLOWING ARE RESPONSES TO YOUR QUESTIONS IN YOUR FEBRUARY 27th FAX: Q. WHAT IS THE MEDIUM OF "OZONE" AND "EARTH SUMMIT" BUS BILLBOARDS? A. THE ORIGINAL FOR EACH BUSBOARD WAS ACRYLIC SILKSCREENS ON PAPER, PHOTOGRAPHED AT THE TDI FACILITIES AND REPRODUCED ON VINYL POSTERBOARDS. Q. ARTISTIC ELEMENTS USED IN CREATING THE POSTERS? A. ACRYLIC BRUSHSTROKES AND SILKSCREENS OF THE ARTIST'S PHOTOGRAPHS (WITH THE ONLY EXCEPTION OF THE PURCHASED RIGHTS TO THE USE OF "ATLAS HOLDING THE WORLD ON HIS SHOULDERS" SCULPTURE IMAGE THAT APPEARS IN THE EARTH SUMMIT POSTERBOARD). Q. BEYOND LETTERING, WHAT ARE YOU HOPING TO CONVEY TO PEOPLE WHO SEE THE POSTERS? A. ALONG WITH THE WORDS, THE IMAGERY SPEAKS FOR ITSELF. Q. IS IT CORRECT THAT YOU PERSONALLY CREATED THESE DESIGNS? A. YES. Q. SMALLER POSTERS FOR SALE TO BENEFIT THE EARTH SUMMIT? A. MR. RAUSCHENBERG CREATED A PAINTING, ENTITLED "LAST TURN --YOUR TURN," WHICH WAS REPRODUCED IN A LIMITED EDITION PRINT OF 200 TO BENEFIT THE PLEDGE FOUNDATION OF THE EARTH SUMMIT CONFERENCE. ADDITIONALLY, POSTERS WERE MADE FROM THE PRINT WHICH, AS THE OFFICIAL EARTH SUMMIT POSTER, WILL BE GLOBALLY CIRCULATED TO PROMOTE AWARENESS OF AND BENEFIT THE EARTH SUMMIT CONFERENCE IN RIO IN JUNE, '92. - Q. DO YOU PLAN TO ATTEND THE EARTH SUMMIT?
- A. YES, FOR A FEW DAYS, AT THE INVITATION OF THE U.N.
- Q. WHAT OTHER WAYS DO YOU WORK ON ENVIRONMENTAL ISSUES?
 HAVE YOU DONE OTHER ENVIRONMENTAL THEMES IN YOUR ART?
- A. PARTICIPATION OVER MANY YEARS THROUGH LETTERS TO GOVERNMENT OFFICIALS, AS WELL AS THROUGH ART AND CONTRIBUTIONS GLOBALLY TO ENVIRONMENTAL CAUSES.

THE FLEDGING ROBERT RAUSCHENBERG FOUNDATION FUNDED THE AFOREMENTIONED BUS BILLBOARDS, PRINTS AND POSTERS, ALONG WITH OTHER PUBLICATION PROJECTS TO PROMOTE PUBLIC AWARENESS OF ENVIRONMENTAL ISSUES, ONE OF WHICH WENT TO THE NATUARAL RESOURCES DEFENSE COUNCIL (NRDC) RECENTLY.

A SIMILAR QUESTION RECENTLY PROMPTED A COUNT OF 57 POSTERS, PRINTS OR ARTWORKS CREATED DURING THE LAST 30 YEARS THAT RELATE TO THE ENVIRONMENT. RECENT EXAMPLES INCLUDE A PRINT TO PROMOTE AWARENESS OF AND BENEFIT THE RAINFORESTS, CIRCULATED VIA "THE GRATEFUL DEAD;" AND PRINTS AND POSTERS FOR THE FIRST EARTH DAY IN 1970 AND AGAIN FOR THE 20th ANNIVERSARY IN 1990.

ART HISTORY BOOKS ATTEST TO THE ARTIST'S CONTINUING FOCUS ON THE GLOBAL ENVIRONMENT IN HIS OTHER ARTWORKS THROUGHOUT HIS 40-PLUS PROFESSIONAL CAREER.
